## What To Do:

Children enjoy seeing books with familiar pictures. Today try taking photos of each room in your home, including the activities your child enjoys doing in each room. Remember to put the photo on the left side of the book and the text on the right side. This helps your child become accustomed to looking from left to right (which is necessary when reading). Read the book to your child, "MY HOME." "This is Emily's room." "Emily loves to rock in the rocking chair." Continue if your child is interested.
