Who Gets WIC?

To be eligible for the WIC Program, applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

Ohio WIC Program Income Guidelines In order to be eligible for WIC, the gross countable income of the economic unit, of which the applicant/participant is a member, must be less than or equal to the Ohio WIC program income guidelines for economic unit size provided in the following chart. WIC income guidelines are updated each year.
