

**HOME VISITOR CHECKLIST
FOR ADDITIONAL LEVEL
USAGE & ALL ITEMS
CHECKED DURING INITIAL
4C HOME VISIT MUST STILL
BE IN COMPLIANCE. IN
ADDITION, EACH FLOOR
OR LEVEL USED FOR CARE
MUST HAVE THE
FOLLOWING: TWO EXITS**

Acceptable exits include the following:

1. Stairs, doors or windows (at least 20" x 24" in size) which lead to the ground level.

2. Windows that are at least 20" x 24" in size which lead to a roof, balcony, or fire escape.

3. Fire ladders which lead to the ground level if windows do not lead to a roof, balcony or fire escape. (Fire ladder must be in place during time of home visit.)

- ___ Smoke detector (installed and in working order)
- ___ Telephone
- ___ Emergency phone numbers posted
- ___ Fire escape plan posted
- ___ All outlets should be covered that are not in use
- ___ Sharp or hazardous objects removed
- ___ Cleaning supplies out of reach or safety latches installed
- ___ Gates (if needed to block steps)
- ___ Fans out of reach
- ___ Portable heaters, wood stoves out of reach

Additional Items (not needed on each level – one per household)
fire extinguisher (with gauge or visible expiration date) flashlight.

First aid supplies including:
