Put these items in a clean, transportable container, i.e., coffee can or plastic box, etc. The container must be stored in an easily accessible and familiar location out of reach of small children.

- _____ Adhesive tape
- _____ Antibacterial soap
- _____ Cotton swabs (i.e. Q-tips)
- _____ Disposable gloves
- _____ Dosing spoon
- _____ Gauze pads, assorted sizes
- _____ Hand towel
- _____ Roller bandages (gauze)
- _____ Safety pins (large)
- _____ Blunt Scissors
- _____ Sling (i.e. bandanna, diaper, scarf, pillowcase)
- _____ Disposable or non-mercury thermometer
- _____ Ice Pack
- _____ Tweezers
- _____ Powdered Milk (1cup sm. container/or ziploc bag)

All items listed must be in your first aid kit.

This list is to be used as a standard guide when preparing your first aid kit. 4C Minimum Standard #14 states, “the provider agrees to have first aid supplies and is knowledgeable about first aid procedures.”

On outings, remember to take your first aid kit with you and children’s emergency cards and change (quarters) for telephone calls.
