333 Training sessions for child care providers held via Zoom

Child care providers attended virtual training **3,354**

518 Child Development Associate (CDA) sessions held

Families searching for safe, affordable child care assisted **798**

145 At-risk families (homeless, special needs children, ESL) counseled on child care options

4C for Children Child Nutrition Program providers virtually visited **426**

4,422 Provider coaching sessions (email, phone, virtual, group) led by 4C for Children coaches
