Pour juice over frozen fruit. Add lemon yogurt. Puree until smooth, stopping to push fruit into the blades of the blender, if necessary. Pour into glasses and enjoy.</p>

20 If it is sunny, go outside to find and make shadows.	21 Make small dots on a piece of paper and then cover the dots with Cheerios.	22 Go outside or to the park and look for the birds.	23 Play store with paper money and your child’s toys.	24 Read!
